

The Emergency Medical Services Association of Colorado has once again taken up the goal of creating a special license plate to recognize Emergency Medical Services. The photo below is a mock up of what the actual plate will look like. Brian Riley is a paramedic with AMR-El Paso County and has taken the lead on this project for EMSAC. He has been able to overcome some significant hurdles to move the project forward which brought previous attempts to a halt. There are only five other states in the nation with a special EMS license plate and Brian has done a great job to bring Colorado this close to becoming the sixth. The only requirement left at this point is to collect 3000 signatures expressing support for the special EMS license plate. Signing the petition doesn't commit you to purchase a plate but does show the Colorado legislature the amount of support for EMS across the state. The EMS license plate initiative will come before the Colorado House of Representatives for a vote in January and the signature petitions must be completed by mid November.
