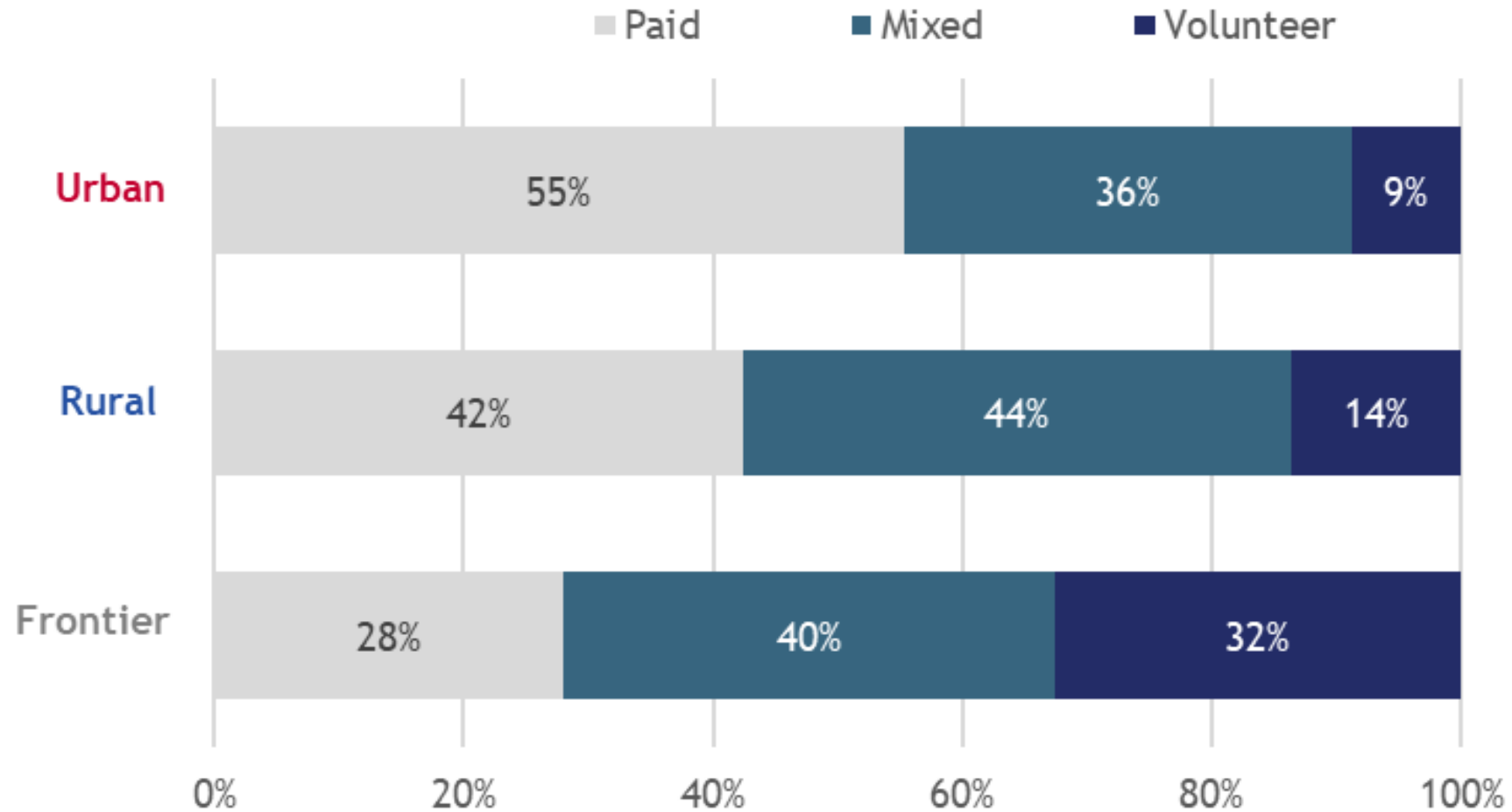

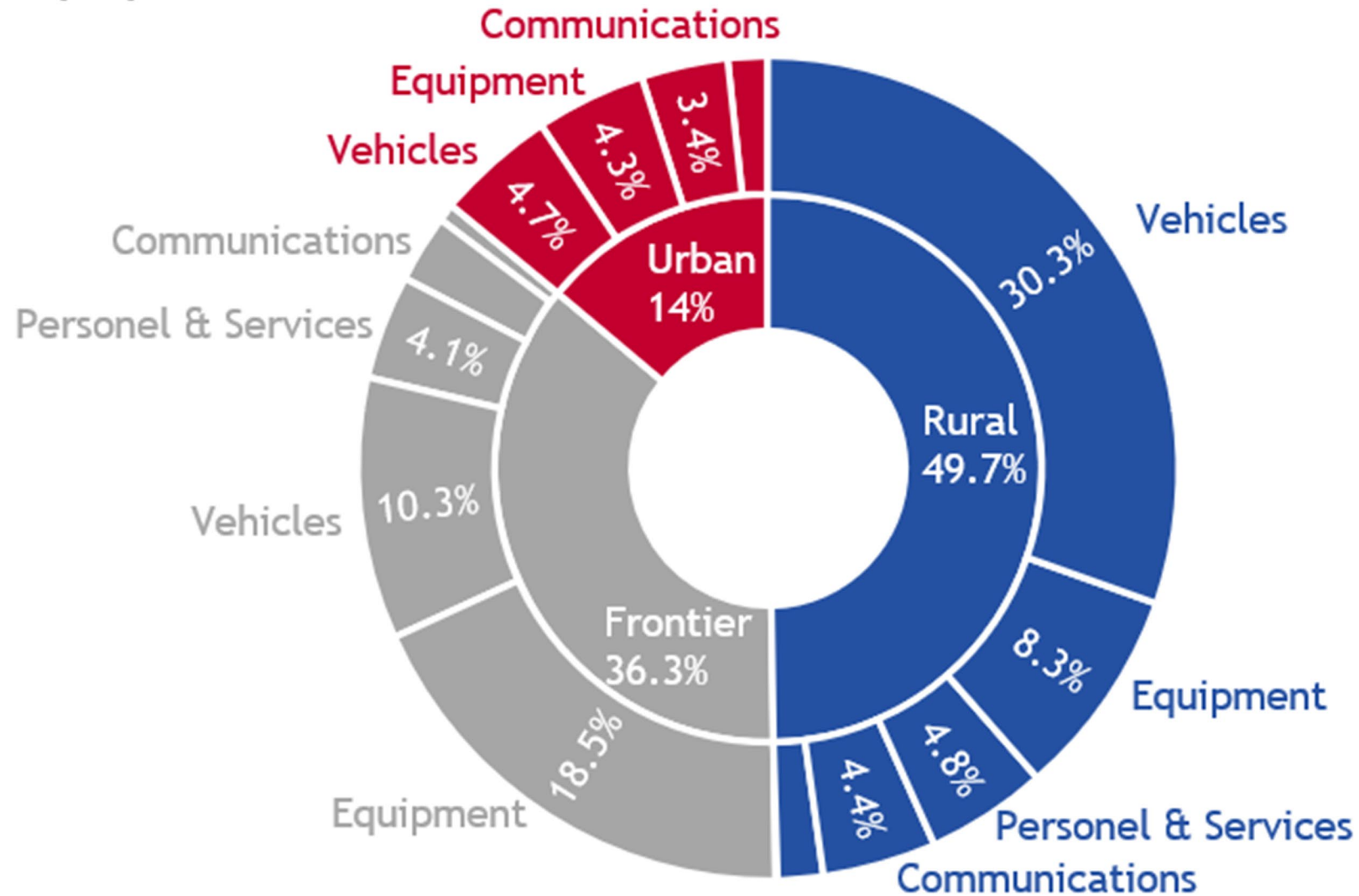

Volunteers are the backbone of EMS.

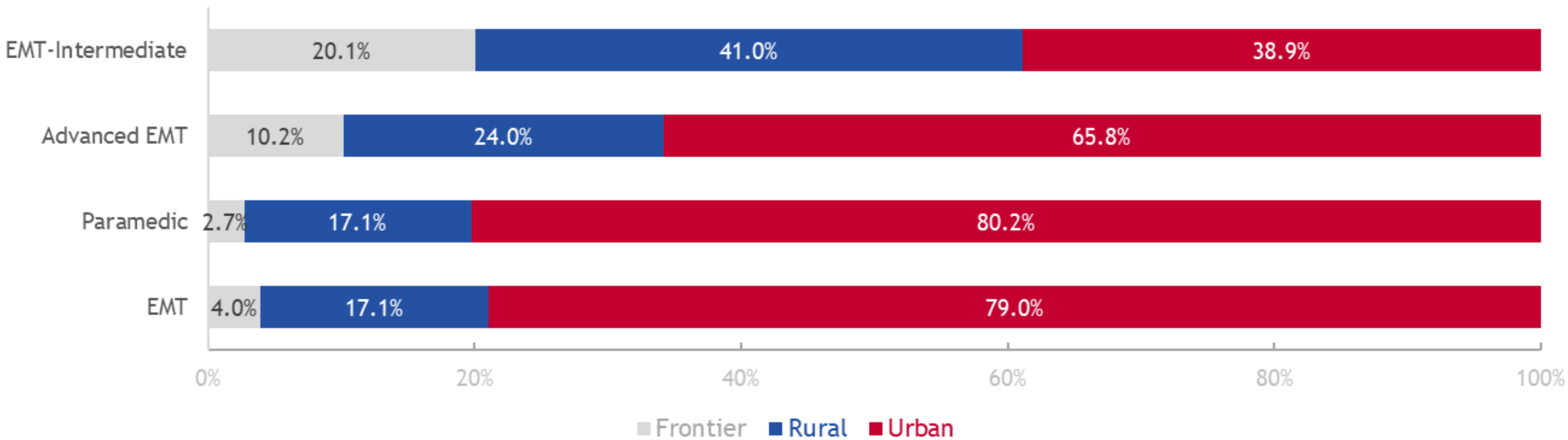
More than **70%** of Frontier and **58%** of Rural agencies rely on volunteer staff.

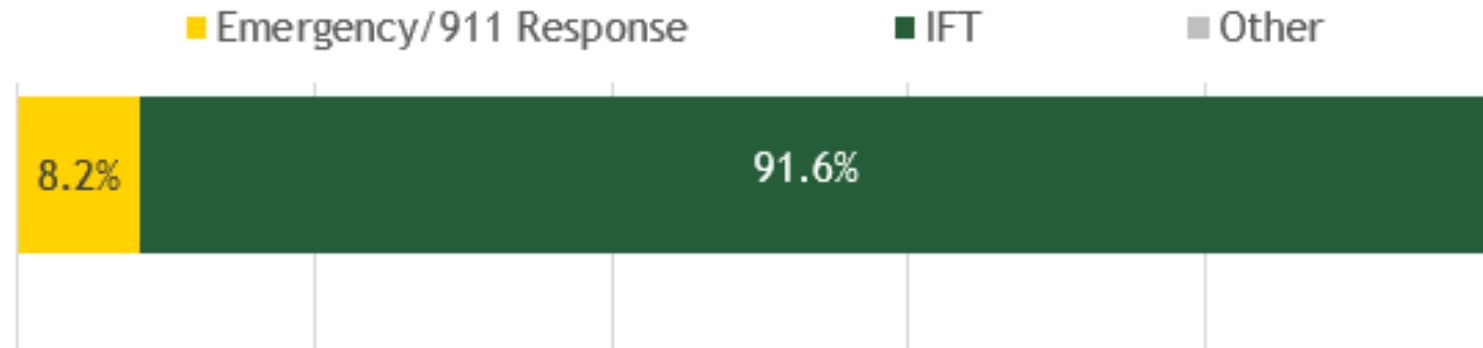

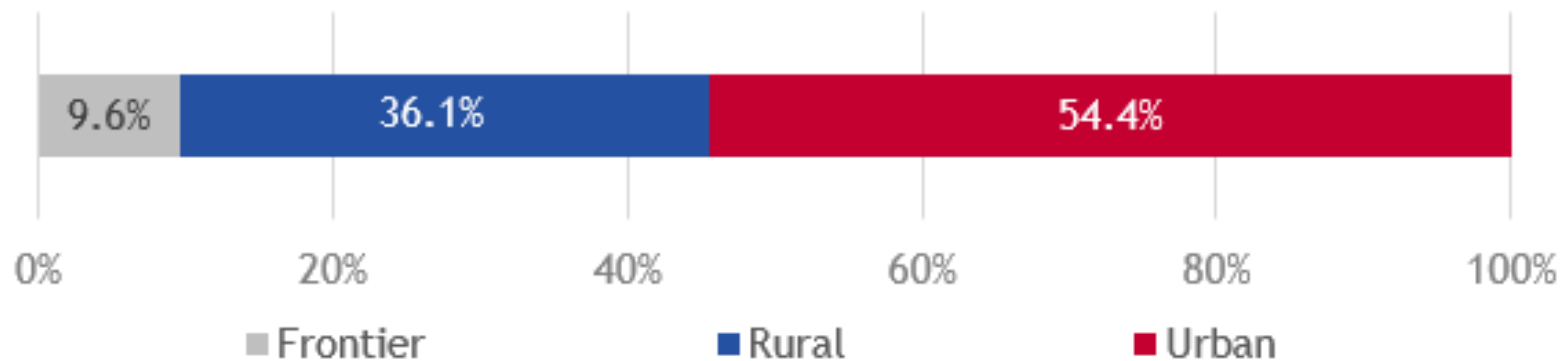

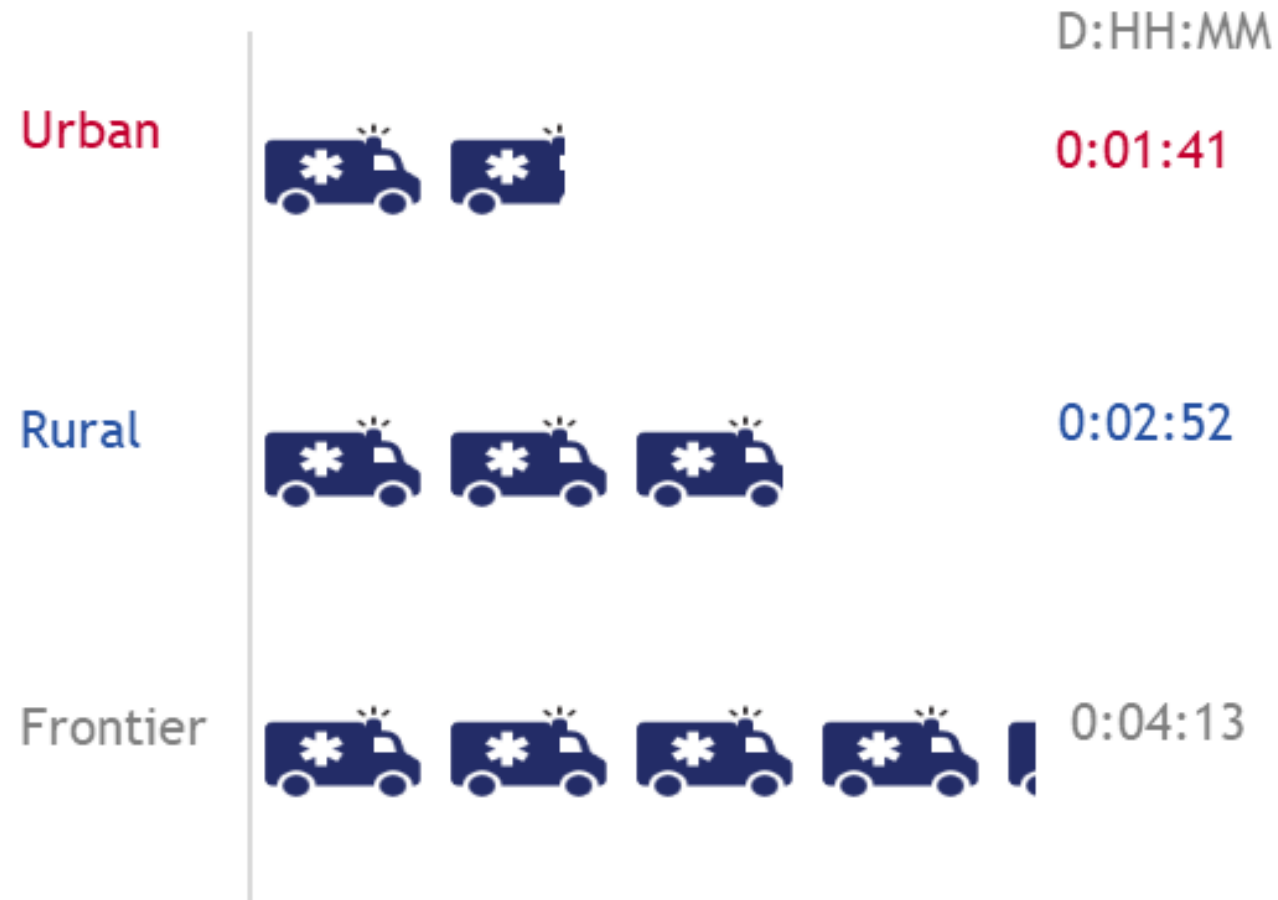
Air Ambulance runs mostly **Interfacility Transports**



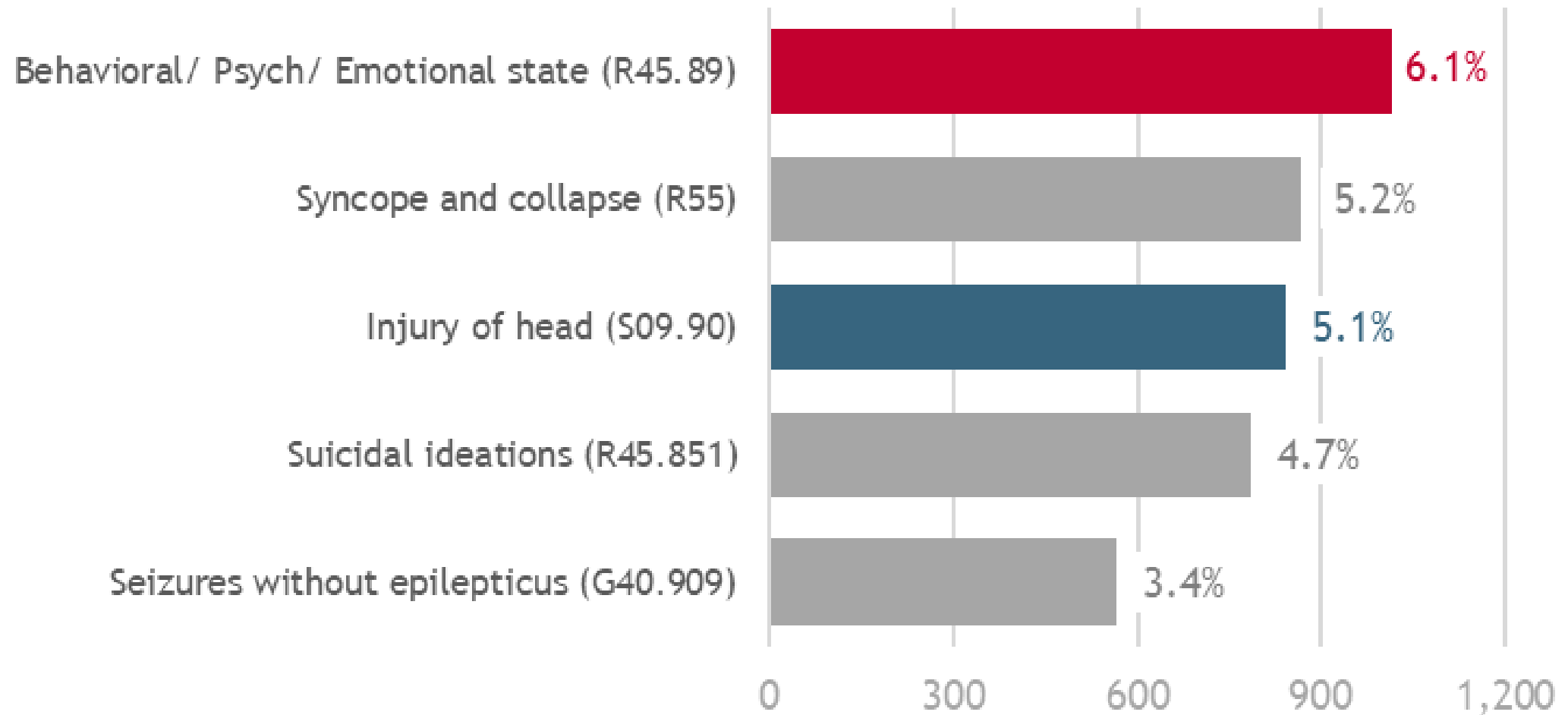
and most air calls are in **Urban** and **Rural** locations.



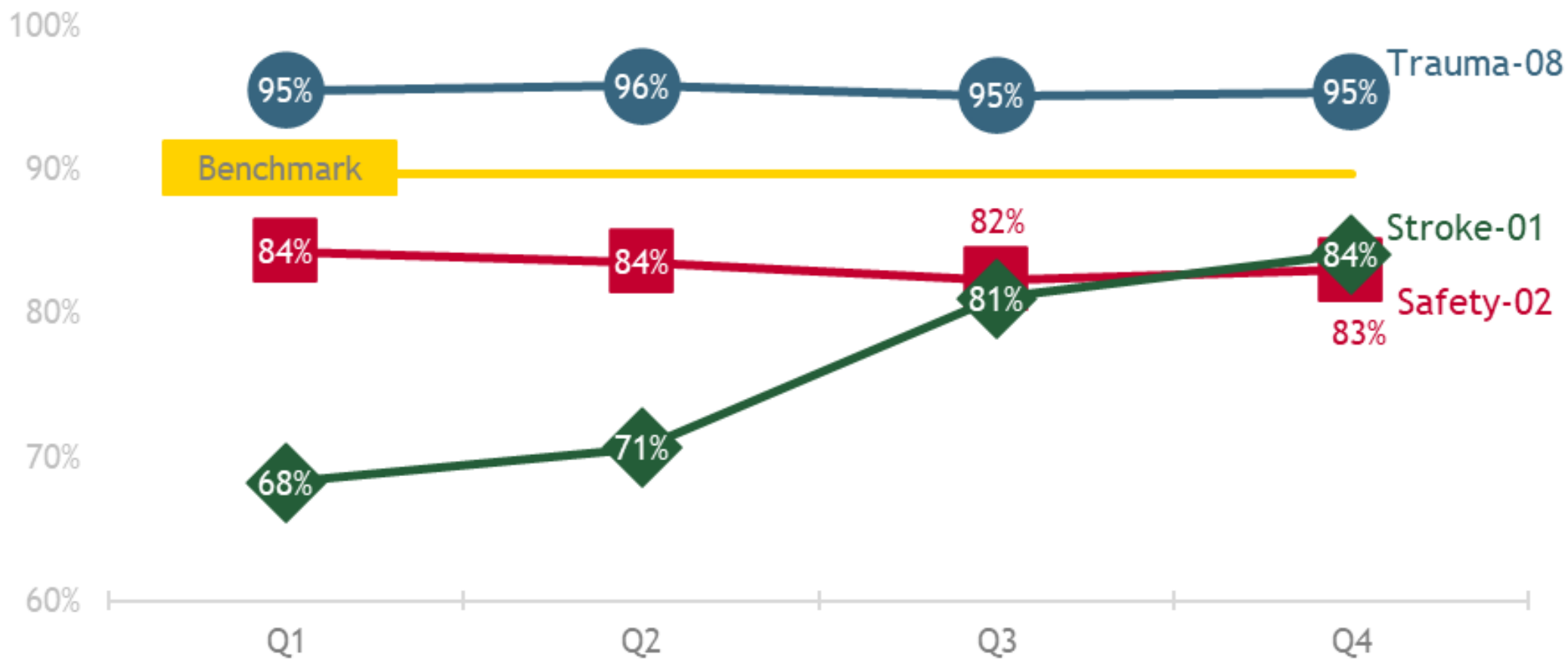
Interfacility Transports from **Frontier** areas take significantly more time on task.



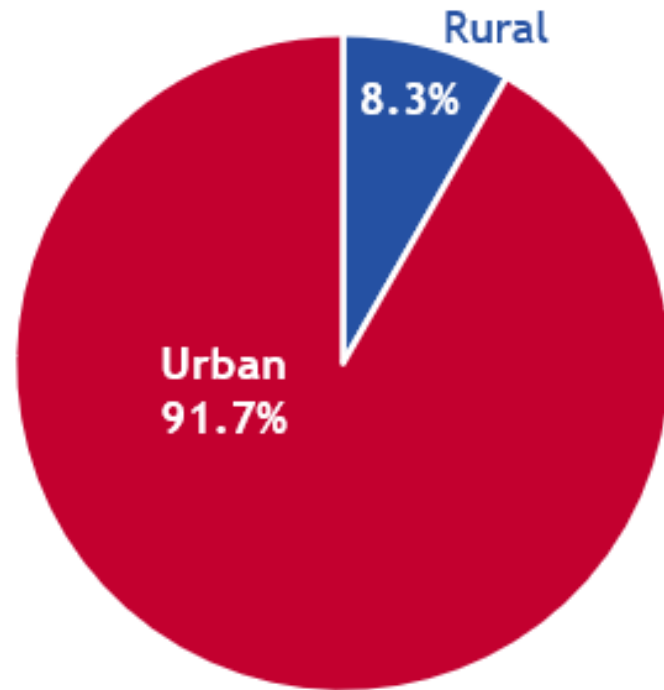
Top 5 Primary Impressions for pediatric patients ages 13-17



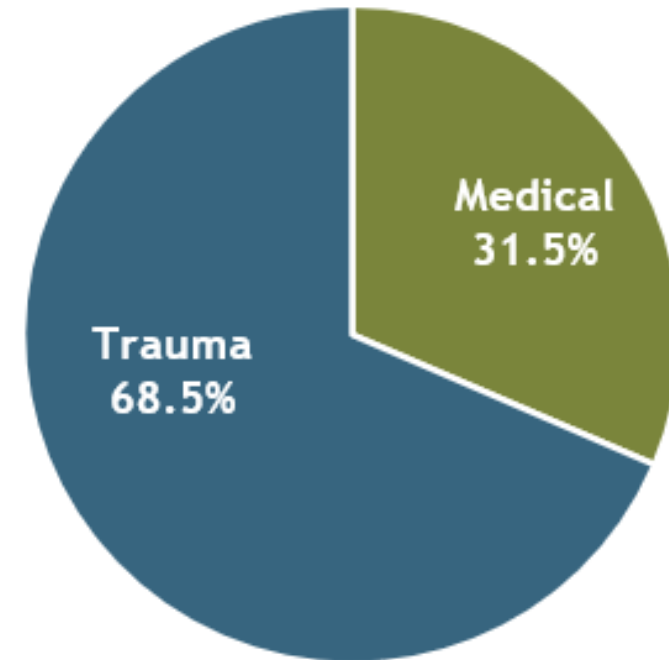
Statewide, the percentage of **suspected stroke patients who had a stroke assessment performed during the EMS response** continues to increase every quarter.



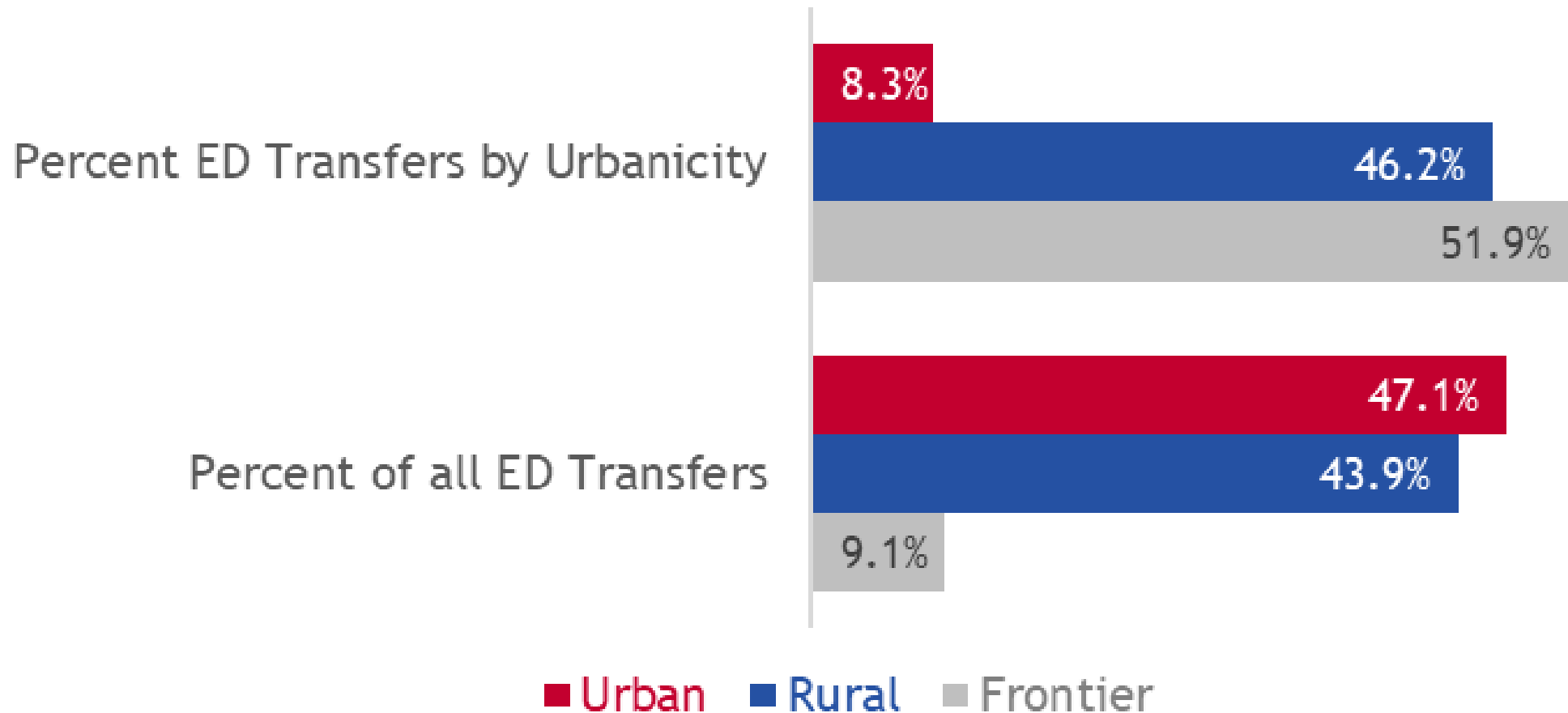
Only **8.3%** of blood administrations occur in **rural** areas.



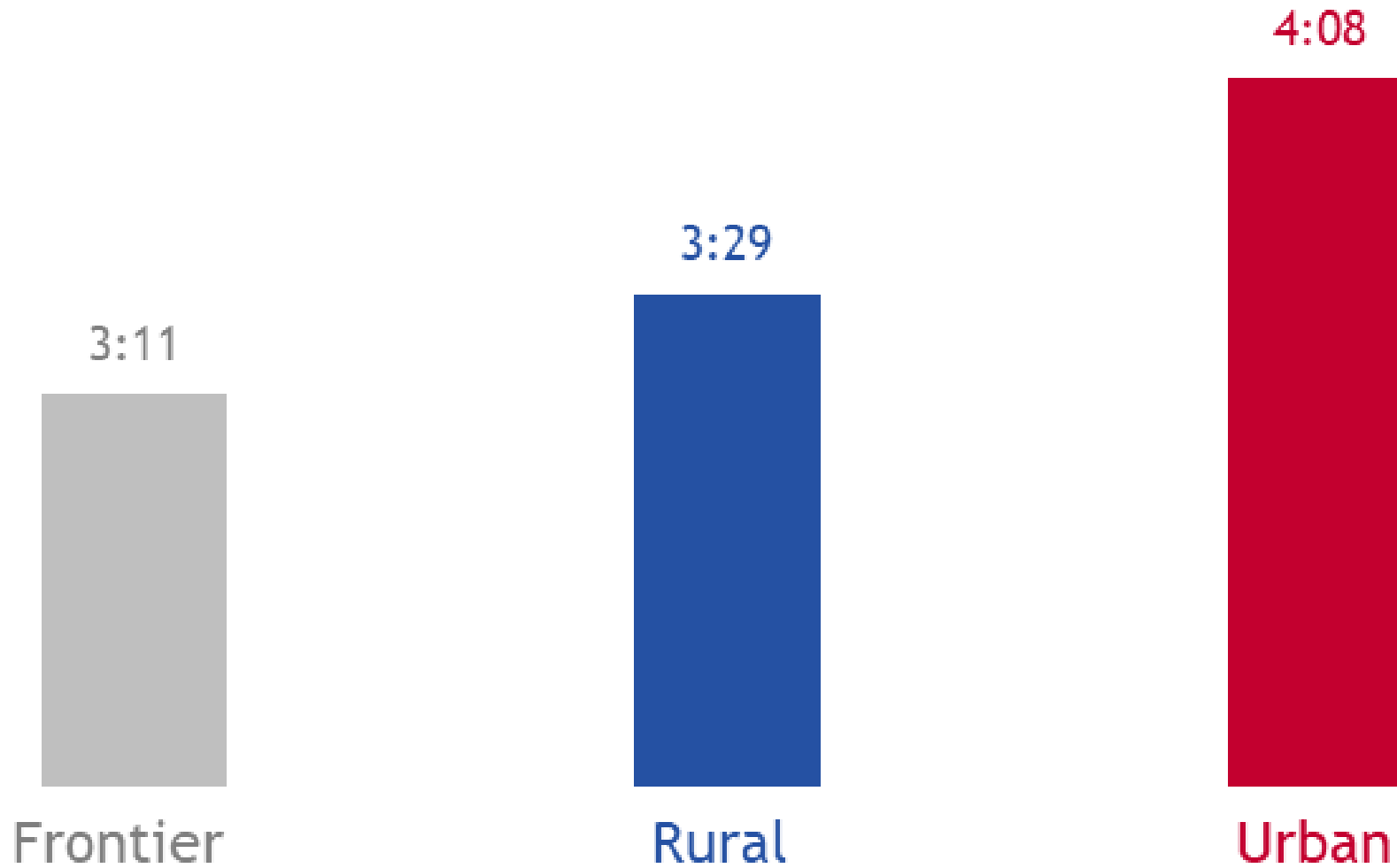
And nearly **32%** of prehospital blood administrations are for **medical** reasons.



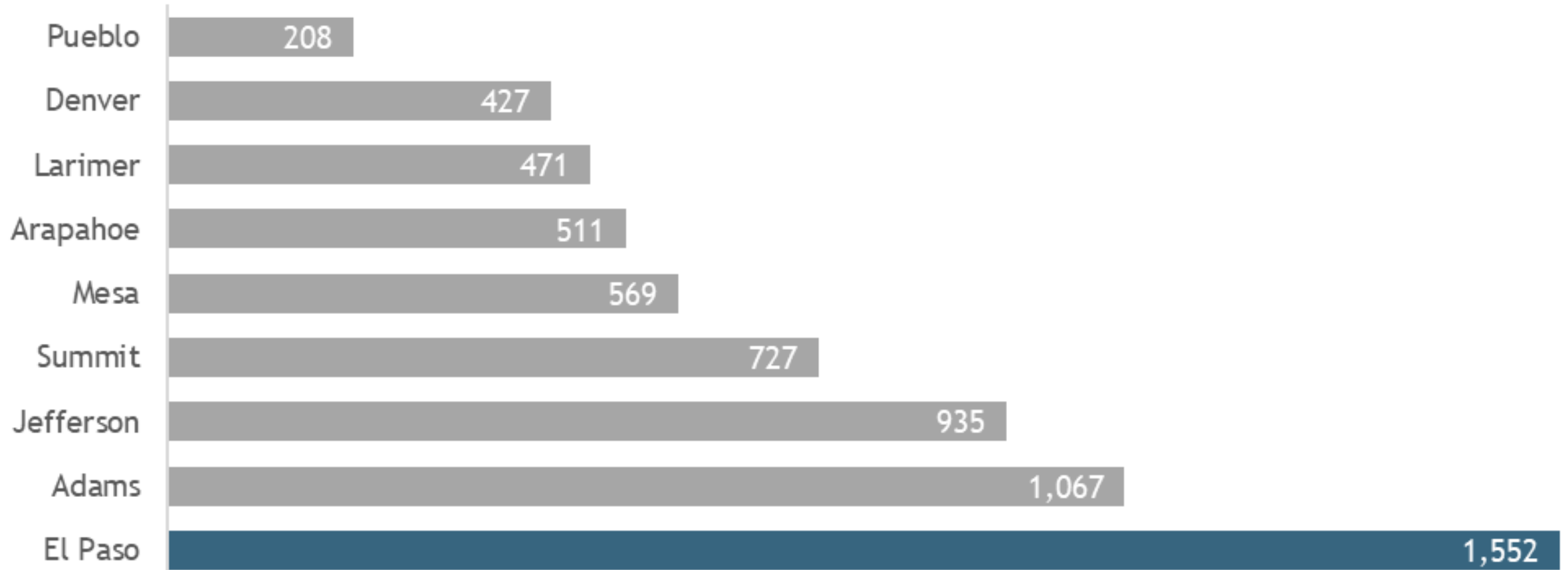
Frontier facilities transfer nearly 52% of their trauma patients but account for less than 10% of all transfers in the system.



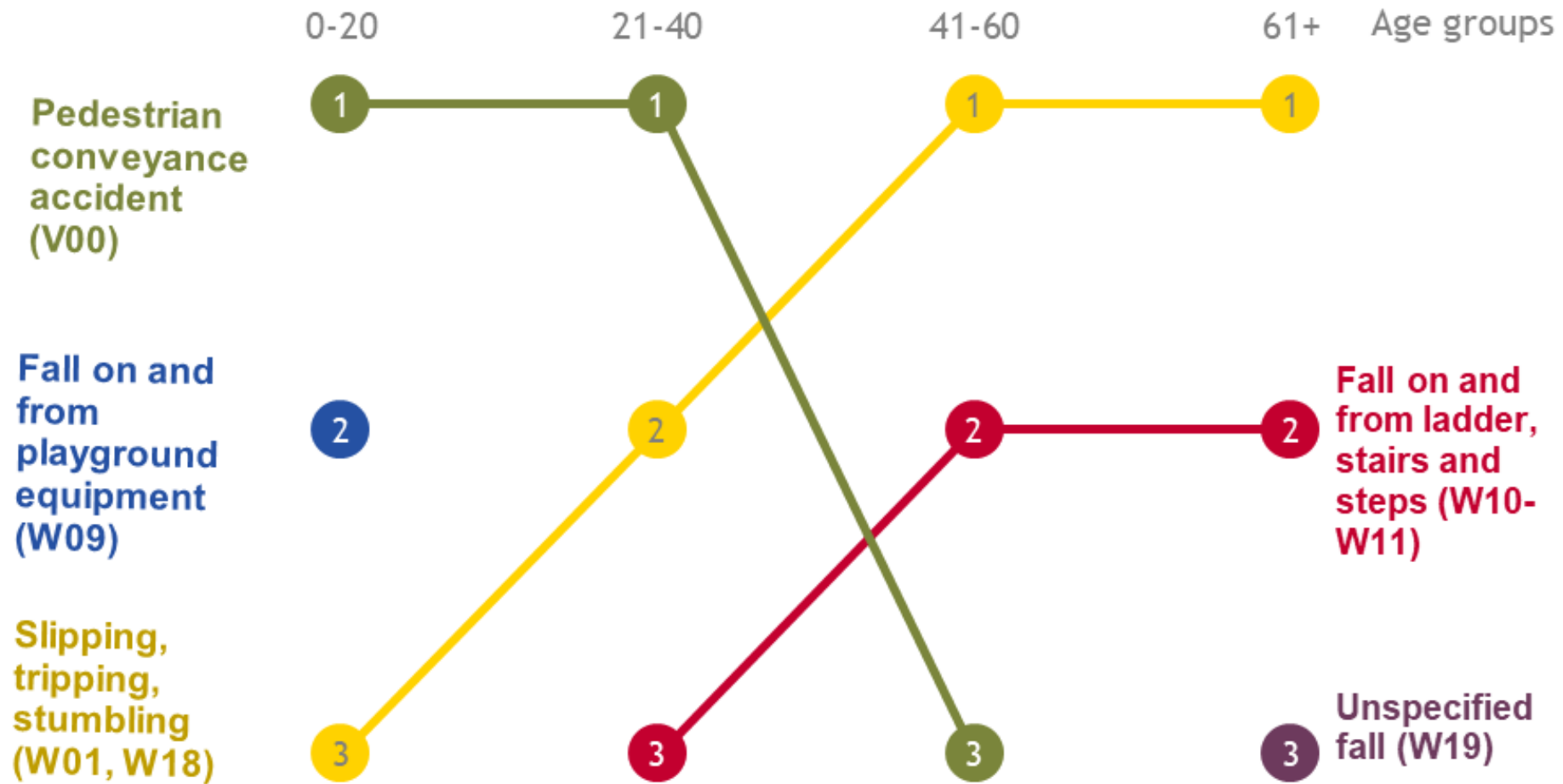
Frontier areas have the **shortest median ED length of stay** at 3 hours and 11 minutes.



El Paso county receives the most transfers of all Colorado counties.



Pedestrian conveyance accidents are most common for those under 40 years; while **slipping, tripping, stumbling is most common** in ages 41 and up.



Motor vehicle injuries are most common in Frontier and **Urban** areas, while **Other Transportation** is the leading injury in **Rural** areas.
